SHABBAT TZAV

Parashat Tzav repeats and enlarges upon the descriptions of the sacrifices already discussed in *Parashat Vayikra*. Included in this portion are details about how the ancient offerings of the *olah*, *minchah*, *chatat*, *asham*, and *zavach shelamim* were performed. We are also given a description of the ordination of Aaron and his sons as priests in the sanctuary and of the dedication of the first sanctuary.

This week's Torah portion will be read via the WLS stream by our Bar Mitzvah Maxwell Aitken. We extend a warm *mazel tov* to Maxwell and his family.

LEVITICUS 7:22-34

22 The Eternal One said to Moses, 23 "Say to the Israelites: 'Do not eat any of the fat of cattle, sheep or goats. 24 The fat of an animal found dead or torn by wild animals may be used for any other purpose, but you must not eat it. 25 Anyone who eats the fat of an animal from which a food offering may be[a] presented to the Lord must be cut off from their people. 26 And wherever you live, you must not eat the blood of any bird or animal. 27 Anyone who eats blood must be cut off from their people.'"

28 The Eternal One said to Moses, 29 "Say to the Israelites: 'Anyone who brings a fellowship offering to the Eternal One is to bring part of it as their sacrifice to the Eternal One. 30 With their own hands they are to present the food offering to the Eternal One; they are to bring the fat, together with the breast, and wave the breast before the Eternal One as a wave offering. 31 The priest shall burn the fat on the altar, but the breast belongs to Aaron and his sons.

32 You are to give the right thigh of your fellowship offerings to the priest as a contribution. 33 The son of Aaron who offers the blood and the fat of the fellowship offering shall have the right thigh as his share. 34 From the fellowship offerings of the Israelites, I have taken the breast that is waved and the thigh that is presented and have given them to Aaron the priest and his sons as their perpetual share from the Israelites.'"
